21. Apologies for Absence

Councillor Slater sent apologies for his absence which was duly accepted by the Highways and Byways Committee.

22. Minutes from the Previous Meeting:

Minutes of the previous meeting were duly signed.

23. Matters Arising:

- **Update on income generation through advertising on the Bus Shelters**

Cllr Howard explained that the documents and photos have been sent to JC Decaux. She went on to say the company are interested in the bus shelters that have the real time boards and access to a power supply within Pevensey.

Cllr Howard was unable to confirm the amount income the Parish Council could receive from this project at present. If this project goes ahead it will be done in 2020/21.

- **Cinque Port Signs.**

The report was circulated to council prior to the meeting. The Committee **Noted** the report.

The Clerk explained the report has been sent to East Sussex County Council to see if they are able to complete the repairs on the signs.

26. Footpath Reports:

Cllr Beaney reported the finger post at Saddlers Lane is being covered by overgrown vegetation. Cllr Beck agreed to speak with the owner.

Cllr Gibson reported that the Bridle Way is covered in mud and is overgrown.

The Clerk will report this to East Sussex County Council.

Cllr MacKinnon requested that a list is put together of all the twittens and pathways in the Parish and who is responsible for them. The Chairman of Highways and Byways will assist the Clerk.

7. Correspondence

The Clerk read an email from the Beachlands Residents Association, requesting to put a notice board on the top half of the end panel of the bus shelter in Beachlands.

Whilst supportive of the residents association, the Committee had several concerns including what the notice board would be made of and how it would be attached to the bus shelter without causing damage. In light of the concerns expressed the Committee decided not to accept the request from the Beachlands Residents Association.

8. Update on Works:

Cllr Rabbitts raised concerns about the recent roof replacement on the wooden bus shelter on Wallsend Road. He explained that roof is supposed to hang over the bus shelter so that the rainwater can run off. He felt that this had not been done correctly. Rubbish was also left on site after the works had been completed.

The Clerk will speak with the contractor.

9. Matters of Urgent Public Safety:

10. Faulty Street Lights

Cllr Withey reported that street light 14 in Waverley Gardens is still not working and street light 16 is being covered encroaching trees from the recreation ground.

Cllr Beaney reported that Cattle Market Street light has started burning during the day again.

The Clerk will chase ESCC about the faulty lights and speak with the local tree surgeon about the trees.

The Clerk advised she will chase Cllr Liddiard with regards to an update on the Pevensey Roundabout streets lights
