



Coast Road Playground Re-opening

The Parish Council is delighted to announce the re-opening of the Coast Road playground from Thursday 9th July 2020.

The Wallsend Road playground and Skate Park will re-open shortly once essential repairs have been completed.

Below is a summary of the guidance for the safe use of Coast Road playground.

Scientific advice suggests that the Covid-19 virus can survive for up to several days on some hard surfaces. The risks are reduced outdoors, where surfaces may be subject to UV light and/or rain. **Whilst all possible practical measures have been put in place the users of this equipment do so at their own choice and risk.**

Regular sanitising of equipment is not considered a practical solution due to the time and resource requirement – sites are not supervised.

DO NOT USE THIS PLAYGROUND IF YOU HAVE ANY SYMPTOMS RELATED TO CORONAVIRUS- FOLLOW NHS GUIDELINES

The following guidance for using the playground is for your safety and protection:

- The recommended maximum number of users at any one time is 5 families in this recreation ground
- Parents are responsible for supervising their children
- Please adhere to Government guidance regarding social distancing
- If the area is busy, please return at a quieter time
- Please remember to regularly use hand sanitiser gel or wipes and avoid touching your face
- Consumption of food and drink within the playground is not recommended
- No dogs allowed in the playground
- Please take litter home or use the bins provided
- Wash hands thoroughly when you get home
